




## **PCS Chart Functions**

## Intake and Output Interpretation









The 24-hour fluid balance is calculated from 08:00-07:59, which means the 24hour period crosses two dates. Expanse allocates the 24-hour balance to the day when the 08.00-07.59 period finishes, so if the 24-hour cumulative balance runs from 08:00 on 14th November to 07:59 on 15th November, it will label it under the 15th of November column.

- Total fluid balance from 8am today can be viewed in the most recent date column (this will appear as tomorrow's date as the 24-hour period finishes at 07.59 tomorrow)
- The most recent complete 24-hour cumulative balance can be viewed in the column with today's date



You can adjust the view to length of stay cumulative, so you can see daily balance and the cumulative.





These fields below house the details for intake and output. You can click on an item to see the details

## The system resets at 08:00 each day.

When viewing hourly and you update the 09:00 output, it also updates the 08:00 entry to reflect the cumulative total for the current 24-hour period.

For example: At 08:00, the value might show **400/400**. After the 09:00 update, the 08:00 entry changes to **400/800**, and this pattern continues for the rest of that 24-hour period.

On paper it would have looked:

08:00 400/400 09:00 400/800 10:00 200/1000

Whereas on Expanse

**at 08:00** 08:00 400/400

at 09:00

08:00 400/800 09:00 400/800

at 10:00

08:00 400/1000 09:00 400/1000 10:00 200/1000
