Prescribing conscious sedation

- The following applies for prescription of medications used for conscious sedation (e.g. midazolam, fentanyl, morphine)
- A midazolam prescription for 1-5mg given in boluses titrated to effect is shown below as an example
- This prescription should be done prior to beginning a procedure (e.g. OGD) such that the required medications can be administered

Click order on the black task bar



Click ENTER




Type the name (or beginning of it) in the search bar

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
Select the route of administration (IV INJ in this case) and the click the downward red arrow



Complete the required information: Dose (1-5mg), Freq (PRN), PRN Reason (sedation), Dose instructions (Titrate to effect)
