Completing a VTE Assessment Consultants / Resident Doctor

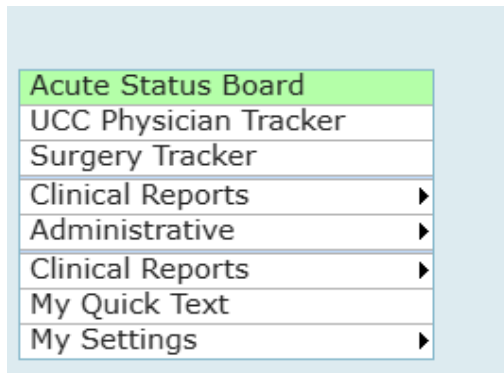
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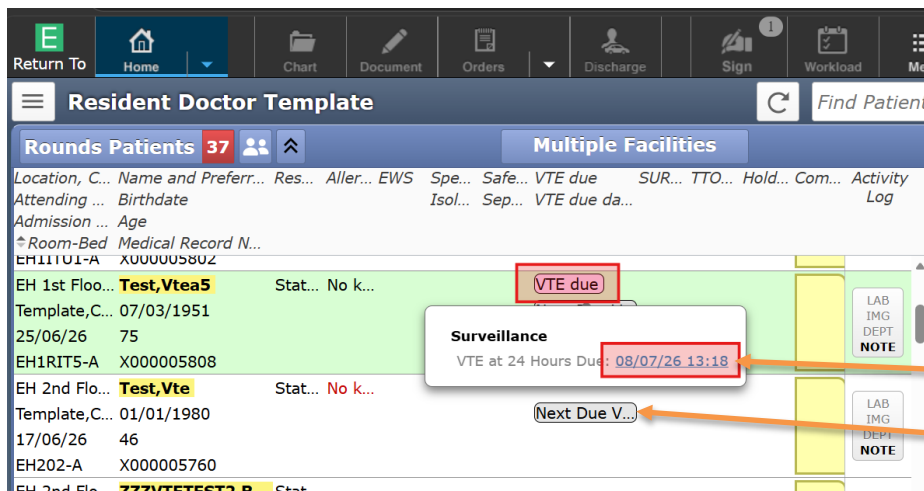
Indications

1. All **Adult** Medical and Surgical patients & **Paediatric**
 - Inpatients and day-case patients over 16 years old
 - At admission,
 - Within 24 hours post admission
 - At least every 7 days thereafter
2. All **Pregnant** patients, from conception to 6 weeks post delivery
 - At admission
 - Within 6 hours post-delivery if admitted for labour

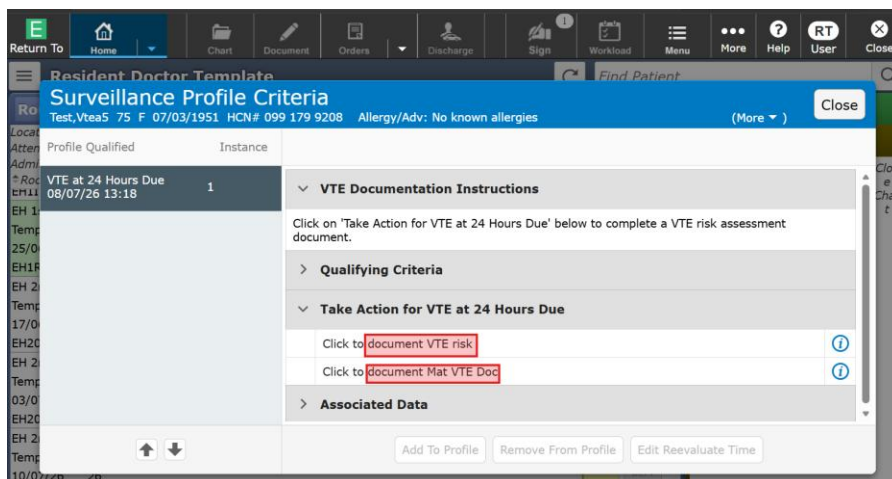
Notifications



- Open the Acute Status Board.



- **Acute Status Board:**
- See the **VTE due** flag indicating that a VTE bleeding and thrombosis assessment is needed.
- **Click VTE Due**
- **Click here**
- **See the Next Due VTE Date and Time for the timing of the next assessment.**
 - If it is *missing*, you **MUST** complete an assessment.



- Under: **Take Action for VTE**
- For Adults and Paediatrics over 16:
 - **Click Document VTE Risk**
- For Pregnant patients
 - **Click Document Mat VTE Risk**

- **Scroll down to VTE assessment** to view the most recent assessment

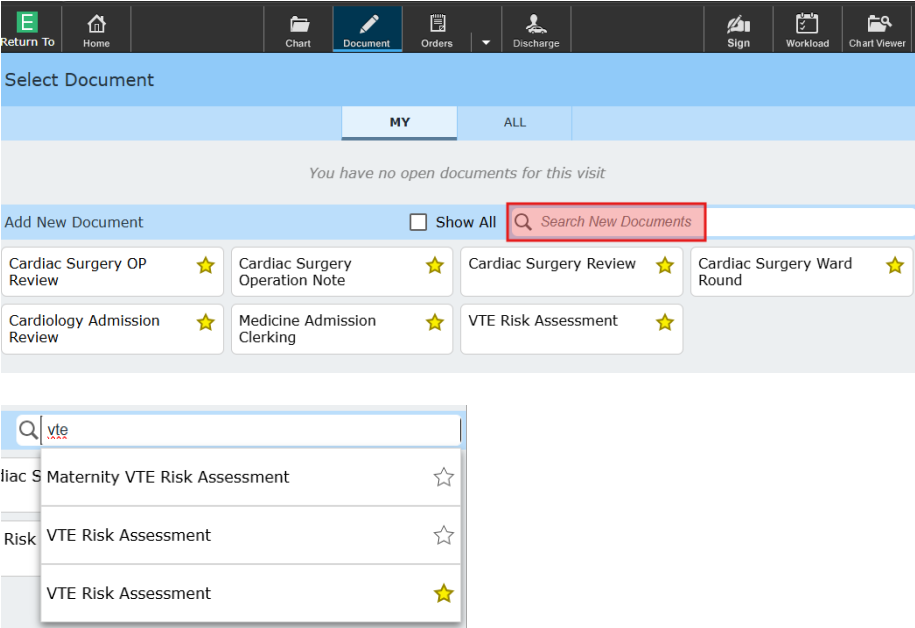
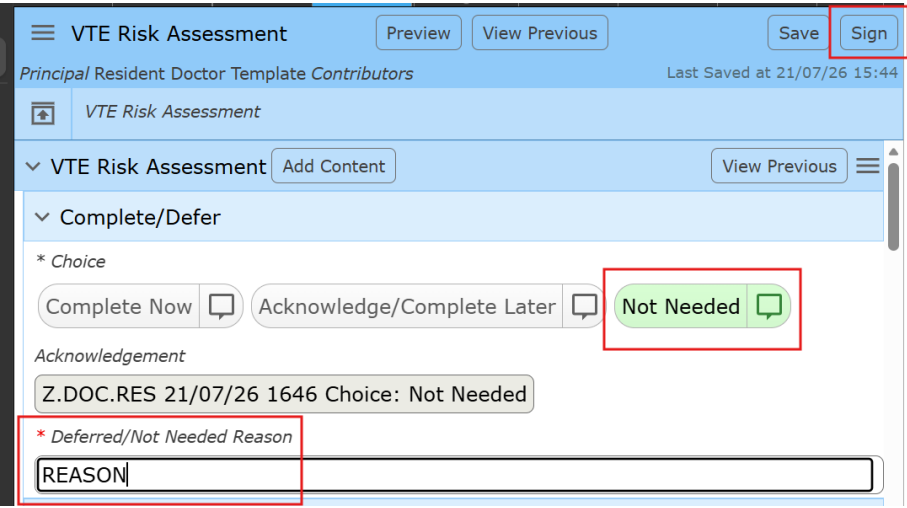
