
Selecting the correct document to use in ICU



There are several document templates (also known as PDOCs) available for use in ICU.

To access these:

- Click on the Document button within the black navigation bar.
- Type "Crit" into the search bar to view the available ICU PDOCs.
- Favourite your frequently used PDOCs by clicking the star on the right-hand side.
- Favourited PDOCs will automatically appear on opening the Document screen, as below:



When to use each one:

- Critical Care Outreach Review: used by Critical Care outreach nurses
- Critical Care Consultation: used by RD on reviewing a patient on the ward
- Critical Care Admission: used by RD on admitting at patient to ICU
- Critical Care Procedure Note: to document any invasive procedures performed
- Critical Care Airway Alert: to detail any difficulties in airway management
- Critical Care Ward Round: used for morning ward round review
- Critical Care Doctor Review: used by RD for PM and Night reviews
- Crit Care Consultant Review: to document Consultant Intensivist review
- Critical Care Nutrition Assess: for ICU dietician documentation
- Critical Care Case Review: to document MDT discussion
- Critical Care Weekly Summary: to document weekly ICU summary
- Critical Care Stepdown Summary: to document ICU summary on discharge
- Critical Care Record of Death: to confirm death and organ donation status
- Diagnosis of DNC Test 1 and Test 2: documentation of Brainstem Death

Addendums can be used in the following circumstances only:

- Corrective addendum: to correct an already saved document
- Interpreter information: to enter further details of the interpreter, if used
